ULPHAT for kids aims to identify medical ailments and facilitates provision of medical care to children and adolescents and to assist in the curative treatment of complex pediatric diseases in resource-poor settings in remote areas of Pakistan.

Apart from the executive committee, ULPHAT is always graced by impassioned medical and non-medical volunteers. These volunteers contribute in various course of actions; which include assisting patients, channelizing treatment, coordinating information and also collecting funds.

HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2015

This year ULPHAT was able to continue its medical camps in various coastal areas of Sindh and Baluchistan including in Abdul Rehman Got. A total of 8084 patients were seen in the 7 medical camps held this year. We also went to Zindagi Trust School and conducted a free medical camp at SMB Fatima Jinnah School for the children.

A Surgical Grand Round was also conducted on 5th August 2015 at the Agha Khan University Hospital. It was titled, 'Smile Train And Aga Khan University – Providing Free Cleft Services To The Poor'. This was to highlight the collaboration between smile train, AKU and ULPHAT joint venture in treating children with cleft palate and lip.

On 1st November, 2015 an invited talk on ULPHAT activities was given during the 12th National Annual symposium of Pakistan pediatric cardiology and cardiac surgery in Agha Khan University.

Like the previous year, a grand iftar party at the orphanage Al Mohsin Hall in Gulberg, Karachi was also hosted.

ULPHAT met its stars from previous years for a follow up. Notably we met Shamshad 4 years after her corrective surgery and were happy to see her doing so well. Another of our stars, Fahad, was operated 3 years back by a great surgeon who came from UK specially to operate on him. He is now doing very well just like other kids his age. He goes to school and enjoys a healthy life. One of our first stars, Amarwanti, who had TOF (Tetralogy of Fallot - complex hole in the heart by birth) whom we met in 2010 floods, underwent successful repair in October 2010 and has blossomed since then. ULPHAT was able to give individual medical assistance to 76 children this year with the help of its donators and medical team. A notable case this year was that of Samir Hussain, a 9 years old boy from a village in interior Sind. He was diagnosed with one of the most complicated and uncommon surgical condition - 2 Basilar artery / left anterior inferior cerebellar artery origin aneurysm. He underwent successful coiling for which we are immensely grateful to our Neurosurgeon and the interventional radiology team.

ULPHAT WELFARE ORGANIZATION NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2015

1 NATURE OF OPERATION

The society was registered as Ulphat Welfare Organization on May 25, 2010 under the voluntary Social Welfare Agencies (Registeration and Control) Ordinance 1961. The registered office of the society is A-159, Block N, North Nazimabad, Karachi. The society is engaged for helping needy persons, specially children who require urgent surgery and can not afford quality intervention and post operative care. Ulphat also provide ration to the needy during Ramzan and other times in a year.

2 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

2.1 Statement Of Compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of International Accounting Standards.

2.2 Accounting Convention

These financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

2.3 Cash & Cash Equivalent

Cash and cash equivalents are carried at cost. For the purpose of the cash flow statement, cash and cash equivalents comprise of cash in hand and deposits held with banks.

2.4 Revenue

Donations received are presented at the time of receipt i.e. when received as cash or deposited in the bank account.

Donations restricted in its use, are utilised for the specified purpose and are classified as donations under restricted fund account. Any income made from such restricted donations is also credited directly in the restricted fund account

2.5 Expenses

All expenses are recognised in the income and expenditure account on accrual basis. Expenses incurred out of donation are reflected in the income and expenditure account, with an equal amount being recognised as "Value of services rendered".


