HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2017

ULPHAT continued to conduct various medical camps. This year we held camps at Yunusabad and SMB Fatima Girls School among other locations. The latter camp was held in collaboration with Zindagi trust. This year a total of 4 medical camps were held in which 5023 patients were treated. We also collaborated with The Rotary Club of Karachi- Bay, and launched a project for helping the Cleft lip and palate patients all over Pakistan. A press conference was arranged at the Press Club Karachi to inform everyone of this project. The patents will be provided free facilities as no money will be charged from them for the surgery or hospital stays. Dr Nuzhat, also spoke on the occasion.

This year again we hosted our regular iftar party at the orphanage Al Mohsin Hall in Gulberg, Karachi. An article was also published this year in Express Tribune on ULPHAT and the various services it has and continues to offer. ULPHAT was invited by TV One in the Apka Sahir show. The show helped raise awareness about the our work.

SAVE ONE SAVE ALL

This year again, ULPHAT assisted 72 children with very complicated issues by providing them with the needed healthcare facilities. One such complicated case was that of Hamna Muneer, a 7 year old girl from Karachi. She belonged to a humble family and her father was an electrician. She suffered from Anomalous Coronary Artery (ALCAPA). She was stabilized initially and then underwent a successful corrective surgery – re-implantation of coronary artery. This procedure has been done for the first time in AKU history and was performed by legendary Dr Asif Hassan who is a visiting professor from UK along with our very own Dr Munir. Hamna recovered well and was discharged. Another of our star, Bushra, was picked up from the medical camp of one of the schools of Zindagi trust. She is a 13 year old girl and had been suffering from heart defect since birth. She belonged to a humble family from Liyari - Karachi. Her father passed away few years back, her mother works at a factory and tries hard to meet ends. Bushra was successfully treated by our committed team of medical professionals.

ULPHAT WELFARE ORGANIZATION NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2017

1 NATURE OF OPERATION

The society was registered as Ulphat Welfare Organization on May 25, 2010 under the voluntary Social Welfare Agencies (Registeration and Control) Ordinance 1961. The registered office of the society is A-159, Block N, North Nazimabad, Karachi. The society is engaged for helping needy persons, specially children who require urgent surgery and can not afford quality intervention and post operative care. Ulphat also provide ration to the needy during Ramzan and other times in a year.

2 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

2.1 Statement Of Compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of International Accounting Standards.

2.2 Accounting Convention

These financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

2.3 Cash & Cash Equivalent

Cash and cash equivalents are carried at cost. For the purpose of the cash flow statement, cash and cash equivalents comprise of cash in hand and deposits held with banks.

2.4 Revenue

Donations received are presented at the time of receipt i.e. when received as cash or deposited in the bank account.

Donations restricted in its use, are utilised for the specified purpose and are classified as donations under restricted fund account. Any income made from such restricted donations is also credited directly in the restricted fund account

2.5 Expenses

All expenses are recognised in the income and expenditure account on accrual basis. Expenses incurred out of donation are reflected in the income and expenditure account, with an equal amount being recognised as "Value of services rendered".


