Benefited a total of 16,266 individuals through medical camps, demonstrating our commitment to ensuring healthcare accessibility across diverse segments of the population.

## Vaccination Efforts

Administered 388 vaccinations during this period, contributing to the strengthening of immunization rates within the community.
